AdventHealth Daytona Beach has 327-beds and is one of the six hospitals in Flagler, Lake and Volusia counties that composes the AdventHealth Central Florida Division — North Region.

Formerly known as Florida Hospital Memorial Medical Center, the organization's parent company changed the name of all wholly-owned entities to AdventHealth on January 2, 2019. Based in Altamonte Springs, AdventHealth is a connected system of care. With more than 80,000 team members, AdventHealth is one of the nation's largest faith-based health care systems with nearly 50 hospitals and hundreds of care sites in nearly a dozen states.

With the mission of Extending the Healing Ministry of Christ, AdventHealth Daytona Beach provides whole person care to heal the body, mind and spirit.

HISTORY

- In 1967, we began serving east Volusia County as Ormond Memorial Hospital.
- In 2000, the facility joined Adventist Health System and became Florida Hospital Ormond Memorial.
- In 2009, the main campus moved from its Ormond Beach site to its current location adjacent to Interstate 95 in Daytona Beach and was named Florida Hospital Memorial Medical Center. The 327-bed facility features all private patient rooms in 718,000 square-feet of space.
- In January 2019, the hospital was renamed AdventHealth Daytona Beach.
