Formerly known as Florida Hospital Waterman, the organization's parent company changed the name of all wholly-owned entities to AdventHealth on Jan. 2, 2019.

Based in Altamonte Springs, AdventHealth is a connected system of care. With more than 80,000 team members, AdventHealth is one of the nation's largest faith-based health care systems with nearly 50 hospitals and hundreds of care sites in nearly a dozen states.

Florida Hospital Waterman is located in the heart of Lake County and was founded in 1938 by Frank Waterman. With the mission of Extending the Healing Ministry of Christ, AdventHealth Waterman provides whole person care to heal the body, mind and spirit.
